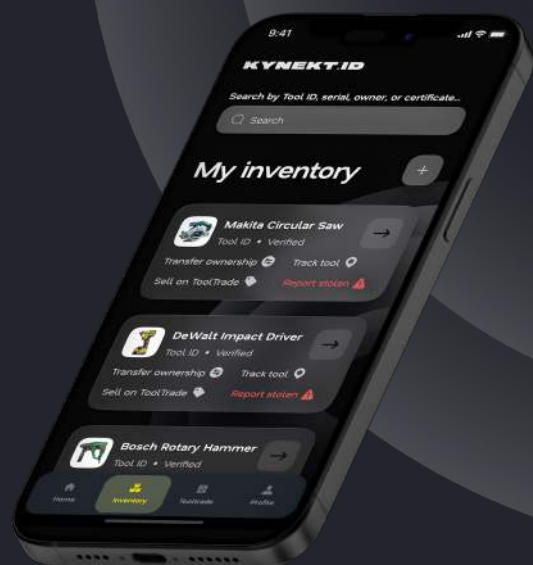

- Purchase receipts or invoices
- Bank statements showing tool purchases
- Photos showing serial numbers
- Manufacturer warranty registrations
- Serial number records linked to your business
- Pre-existing tool registers or inventories

The key requirement:

- **Records must exist before the theft.**
- **Recreating ownership after tools are gone often leads to claim refusal.**

-  Notes on condition

To stay protected in 2026, follow these best practices:

- Log tools as soon as they're purchased
- Photograph tools before first use
- Record serial numbers clearly
- Assign tools to vans, sites, or team members
- Update records when tools move
- Review your register quarterly

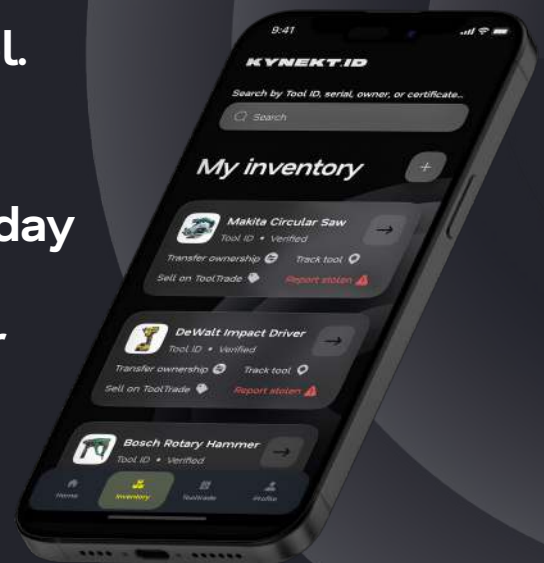
